



The Small Litany

Deacon: Again and again, in peace, let us pray to the Lord.

Deacon: Help us, save us, have mercy on us, and protect us, O God, by Your grace.



Priest: Commemorating our most holy, pure, blessed, and glorious Lady, the Theotokos and ever-virgin Mary, with all the saints, let us commend ourselves and one another and our whole life to Christ our God.



The Prayer of the Third Antiphon

Priest (in a low voice): Lord, You have granted us to offer these common prayers in unison and have promised that when two or three agree in Your name, You will grant their requests. Fulfill now, O Lord, the petitions of Your servants as may be of benefit to them, granting us in the present age the knowledge of Your truth, and inthe age to come eternal life.

And he exclaims:

For You, O God, are good and love mankind, and to You we offer glory, to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, now and forever and to the ages of ages.

(Immediately the Resurrectional Dismissal Hymn of the Mode, of the Feast, or of the Saint of the day, together with the appointed verses, is chanted.)
