Holy Trinity

January 1 – St. Basil

Let us all now honor the God-inspired * revealer of heaven, and the mystic of Christ the Lord, * the shining luminary and son of Cappadocia, * and Caesarea's Bishop, Basil indeed the Great.

January 7 – St. John the Baptist

Holy John the Baptist, with your right hand * you baptized the Lord, who led His people across the Sea. * Therefore you are greater than all the other Prophets, * and we extol the grace that Christ God has given you.

January 10 – St. Gregory of Nyssa

Father, we salute you and sing, Rejoice! * Treasure house of wisdom, God-inspired teacher of the Church, * instrument that plays the divine and godly doctrines, * O Gregory of Nyssa, all-blessed Saint of God!

January 17 – St. Anthony

We salute you, Anthony, O rejoice! * Pioneer and teacher of angelic ascetic life, * you were in the desert of Egypt like a pillar * of cloud to guide monastic fathers, who boast in you.

January 25 – St. Gregory the Theologian

Rejoice, O divine and celestial mind! * Rejoice, fire-breathing mouth! Rejoice, watchful eye of grace! * Theology's wellspring, and Orthodoxy's trumpet, * and mystic sublime truth, wise father Gregory!

Today, all-immaculate Mary brings * to the holy Temple as a babe the Maker of all. * Symeon receives Him in his aged embraces; * and he declares Him God, who took flesh to save the world.

February 6 – St. Photios

Most luminous mystic of the Church of Christ, * champion and defender * of the Orthodox everywhere, * scourge of the impious, the glory of the hierarchs, * great priest and theologian, * St. Photios, rejoice.

February 6 – Sts. Barsanouphios and John

Rejoice, Barsanouphios, sacred man * and God-bearing teacher * of devout and monastic life. * Treasury of grace, holy John, we all salute you. * Our two divine directors * and patron saints, rejoice!

February 8 – St. Theodore the General

The dignified beauty of martyr saints, * invincible champion defending the Church of Christ, * rejoice, O thrice-blessed St. Theodore the General, * our helper and the namesake and treasure of gifts of God.

February 10 – St. Haralambos

Let us sing in honor of that sublime * priest among the martyrs and that martyr among the priests. * In the world he pours out his miracles like rivers. * Therefore we magnify him, great St. Haralambos.

March 25 – Annunciation

Gabriel the Archangel now with awe * announces to Mary the good tidings and says: Rejoice! * The Maker of all is conceived within a pure womb, * to save what He created. Marvelous miracle!

April 1 – St. Mary of Egypt

Enduring your nakedness with resolve, * you clothed in great shame the one who stripped you of Christ before. * Now, O holy Mary of Egypt, you are wearing * the glorious apparel of immortality.

April 23 – St. George

As a trophy-bearer you proved to be * a great man in contest, and in miracles most renowned. * O thrice-blessed George, you were manifestly known as * the Church's great protector, the martyrs' pride and joy.

April 24 – St. Elizabeth

Promised to the Lord as a pious gift, * through your pious lifestyle, O Elizabeth, you received * blessings that He promised, devout and holy Mother. * May we receive them also by your all-holy prayers.

May 9 – St. Christopher

Holy Martyr Christopher, you were strong, * mighty, and undaunted, in appearance and in your mind. * With love for your Maker, competing beyond nature, * you terrified and struck down the hordes of enemies.

May 21 – Sts. Constantine and Helen

Let us sing in praise of the royal Saints * Constantine and Helen, those divine torches of the Faith. * They were imitators and equals of Apostles, * the pride and joy of Christian rulers and emperors.

June 29 – Sts. Peter and Paul

Peter, the cherubic chariot of God, * and heavenly Paul, the seraphical vehicle, * the fiery tongue of the God-man Christ the Logos, * I pray you to deliver me from fire of hell.

June 29 – Apostle Paul

We salute you, singing to you, Rejoice! * Preacher of the Gentiles, and their teacher and guiding light, * the inerrant guide of the Church of Christ forever, * the beauty of Apostles, great luminary Paul!

Prophet * Elijah, to abide in life incorruptible.

July 22 – Mary Magdalene

Holy Mary Magdalene, as you came *

He sent you * announcing the good tidings to
His Apostles and friends.

July 22 – St. Markella

Rejoice, O inviolate bride of Christ, *

those who honor you.

July 25 – Saint Anna

Rejoicing you passed on to life on high, *
Anna, as the mother of the one who gave birth

July 26 – St. Paraskeve

Godly-minded martyr Paraskeve, * as the

August 10 – St. Lawrence

We salute you, Deacon of Christ, Rejoice! * In the church you ministered with piety in His grace. * Rejoice, Martyr Lawrence, for bravely through the fire * you finished your inspired contest of martyrdom.

August 15 – Assumption / Dormition

Into heaven gloriously assumed, * you stood at the right hand of your Son, who is King of all, * decked in immortality as if gold apparel. * And now, O Virgin Mary, you are the Queen of all.

August 27 – St. Phanourios

We salute you, holy athlete of Christ: * Rejoice! For you sympathize with all, answering their prayers. * Rejoice! For you greatly assist all pious Christians. * Now all the Church rejoices in you, St. Phanourios.

September 6 – Archangel Michael

O heavenly Michael, in Colossae * you made your divine church an unending fountain of cures, * glorious Archangel, effecting the salvation * of souls and restoration of the bodily health.
